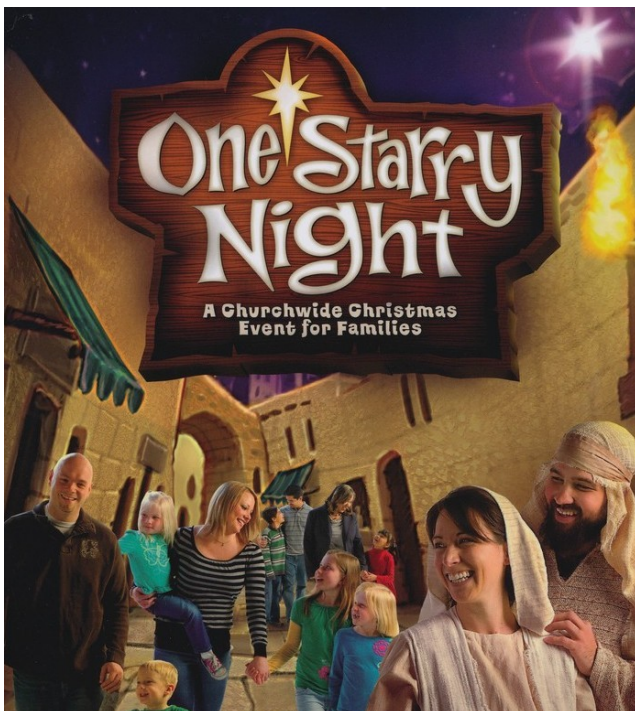

Stewardship Report

I want to thank each of you who have participated in our Stewardship Drive this year. We have received 78 pledges totaling \$270,952. The really wonderful news is that on average, these 78 persons or families have pledged to increase their giving by 8.8%. Wow! Thank you!

Based on the 2011 giving records of those who currently give to the church but did not pledge, added to the amount pledged, we anticipate that our contributions next year will be at least \$378,380. When we add to that amount what we anticipate from loose plate offerings, church school offerings, interest earned, building use fees, and a grant, we believe that our total income for the year will be at least \$433,295. This amount is \$35,684 short of our total 2012 budget of \$468,979.

Some of you may be asking how we can be short that much when so many increased their pledge. The answer is that among those who have been giving in the past some have died, some have moved away, and some (who did not turn in a pledge) were not able to give as generously this year as they have in the past so our estimates of what they will give in the future went down.

So, how will we meet our budget for next year with a possible \$35,684 shortfall? The faith answer is that God will provide. He always has in the past, and we will trust Him to do so for next year. The practical answer includes: First, our estimates are very conservative, especially among those who did not turn in a pledge card, and some may be more generous next year than this year. Second, we will have new members as the year progresses who will begin giving, and, thus, possibly increase our income. Third, we will be as conservative as possible in our spending and try to keep our spending within actual revenue. And, finally, if our expenditures do exceed our income next year, we have enough reserves to cover the difference and can make any necessary budgetary adjustments in the future to match our income.

I am always a little cautious and concerned when it comes to finances, but I would have to say that I am thrilled with the generosity of this congregation. You are providing for the needs of our church, and we are going forward with strength. Thank you!
